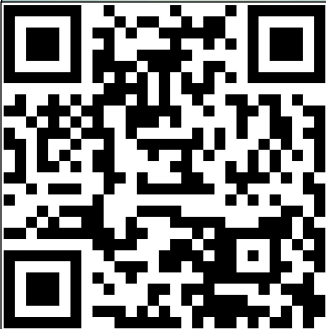

intercede for us before the Lord.

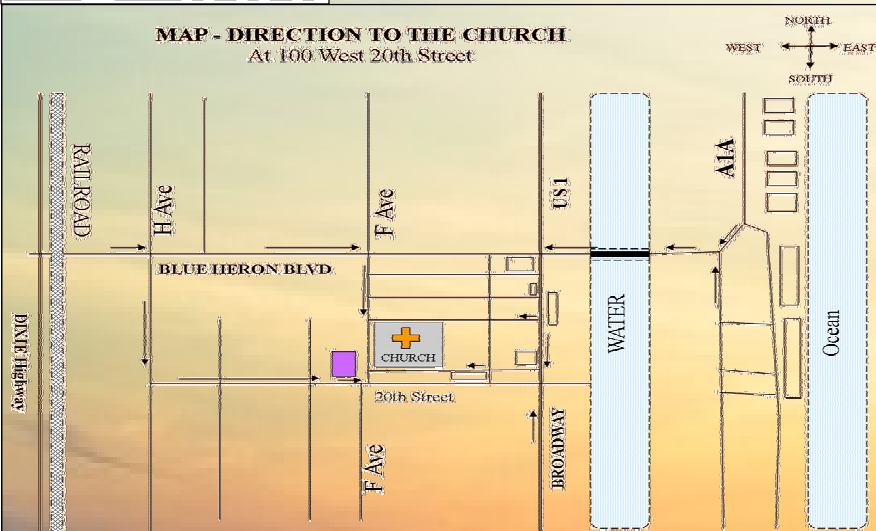
You recognized true peace

May 24, 2026 - PENTECOST

"Receive the Holy Spirit" (John 20:23)

It was time for the young church to be confirmed. After being confirmed by the Holy Spirit, the disciples of Jesus proclaimed the Good News of God's salvation to the world.

"Receive the gift of the Holy Spirit," Jesus said. "Whose sins you forgive will be forgiven, and whose sins you retain will be retained." It is so difficult for the church, for you and for me, to proclaim the Good News by standing as testament and reminder of the sin of the world. Yet, God's salvation, as essentially desired by the people of the world, relates closely to the reality of sins.

People of the world want to be saved, but not to be saved from their sins (Peace of Soul, Fulton J. Sheen). They chase after many forms of salvation as they pursue their temporal needs and desires. People don't want what God wants for them. Only when people of the world acknowledge that their troubles are caused by sins and that their decisions, endeavors, and activities are deeply influenced and directed by sinful inclinations, may they allow the saving mercy of God to embrace them.

You and I take on a challenge when we accept the task of making God known to the world and calling its people to be known by God.

The difficulty for the church, for you and me, is that we don't want to hurt people by reminding them of their sins. We try to be nice to them, because we are afraid that they may run away like our young people often do after the sacrament of Confirmation. We, then, turn the church into a theater to lure them back in.

Be not afraid! Your faith will guide you as you proclaim what the Holy Spirit of God tells you. You will be rejected and abandoned. But God of whom you testify will always be with you.

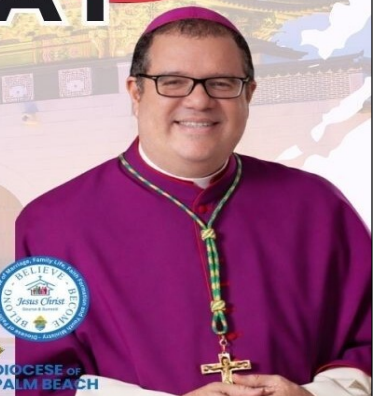
