Prayer for the Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi

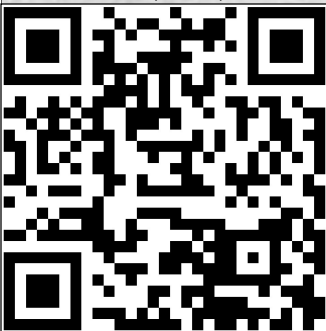
Saint Francis, our brother,

that breaks down every wall.

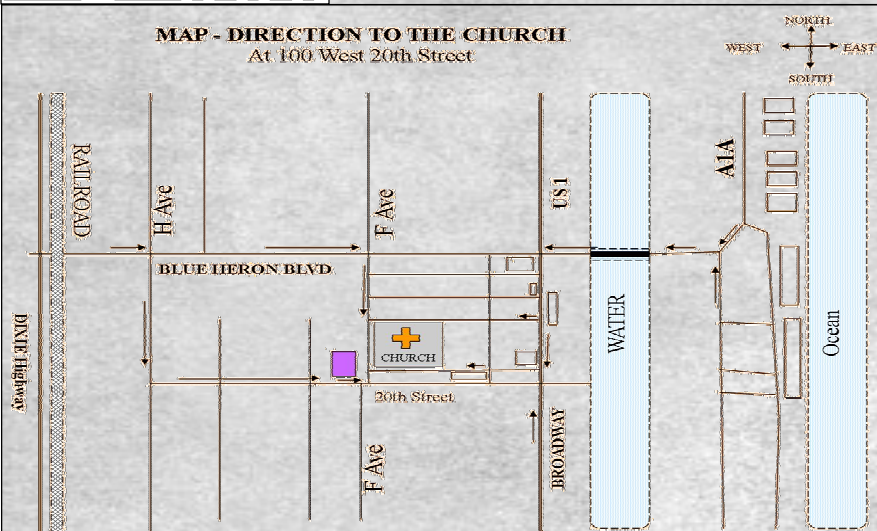
You who, unarmed, crossed the lines of

**June 7, 2026 - SOLEMNITY OF
THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST**

“The Bread That Came Down from Heaven”

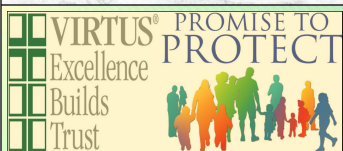
This is the mystery of faith: Jesus said, “I am the bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I will give is My flesh for the life of the world.” Yet when the Jews, the contemporaries of Jesus, heard Him say this, they struggled with it, and so do many of today’s Christians and Catholics.

This is the mystery of faith: after the consecration of the bread and wine at the altar by the priest, they become the Body and Blood of Christ. If the results can be confirmed by a blood test in the laboratory or examined under a microscope, can it still be a mystery of faith? Yet this is what many people look for and expect in order to satisfy their senses. This is also what the Jews expected Jesus to do for them.

Moses explained God’s intentions to his people in the desert: “He (God) therefore let you be afflicted with hunger, and then fed you with manna, a food unknown to you and your fathers, in order to show you that not by bread alone does one live, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of the LORD.” (Dt 8:3)

During Mass, we respond to the mystery of faith by saying, “Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.” This is the mystery of the Lord, Who offered Himself to be food for us, the food that nurtures the Mystical Body of Christ, the Church. We receive the Body and Blood of Christ so that we can grow up as members of His Body, the Church. There is no Eucharist without the Church, and a church without the Eucharist cannot live, as St. Paul said, “The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf.” (1 Cor 10:16-17)

Even though receiving Holy Communion is beneficial for an individual soul, the spiritual benefit must be understood as being for the Mystical Body of Christ, which is the Church, God’s family. This is the mystery of faith.

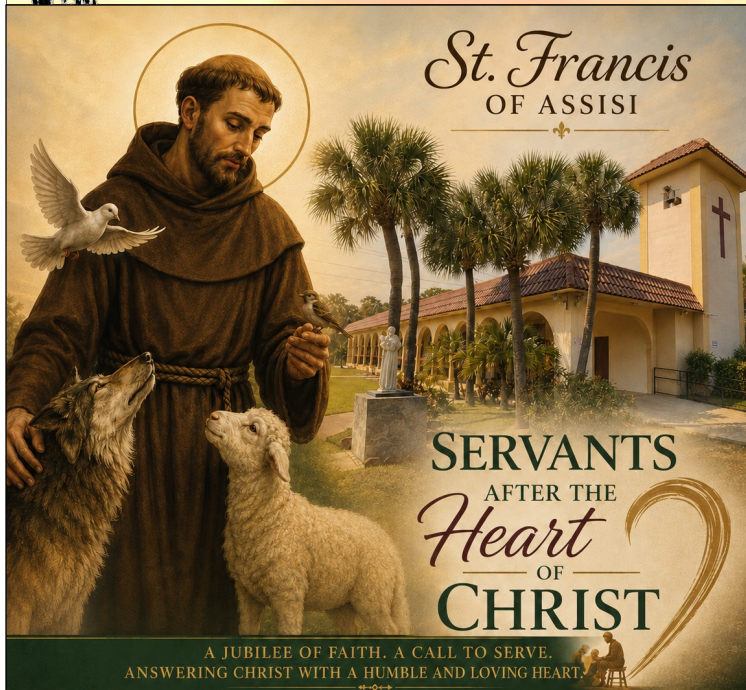
