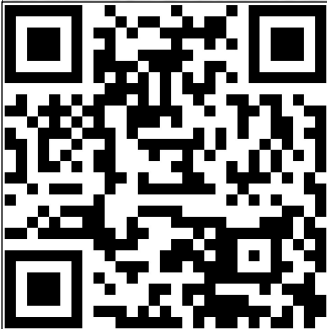

intercede for us before the Lord.

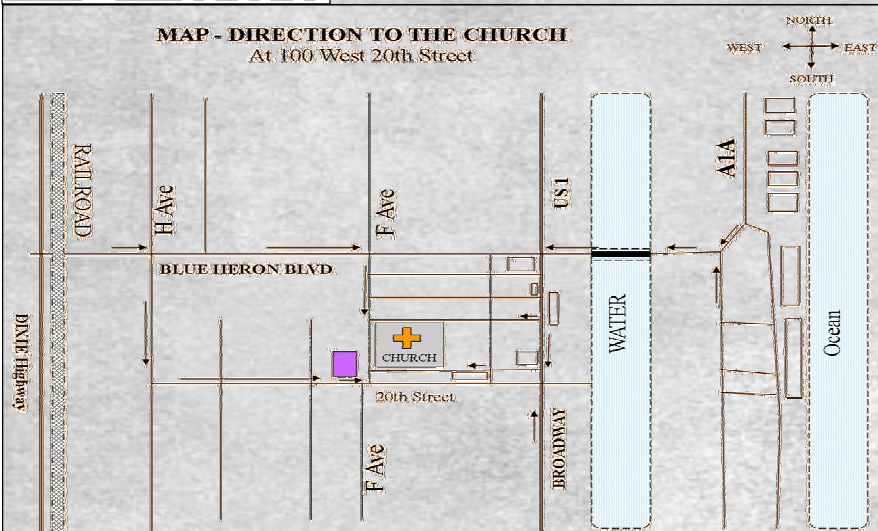
You recognized true peace

## May 0 31, 2026 - SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

“God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world.” (Jn 3:17)

It is amazing to realize that in the Gospel those who were known to be sinners did not kill Jesus, but the righteous did.

In His life, this is what Jesus experienced: the difference between a sinner and a righteous person is that the sinner knows his sin and confesses it and the righteous person denies his sin, and if he sees any he would blame on someone or something else.

The problem of our world is not that people have sin; the true problem is that they deny it, and therefore they refuse to allow the forgiving power of God to wash away their guilt. The greatest damage the Devil does to humanity is not that he seduces men and women into sins, but convinces them that all the troubles they suffer are not sins but just the consequences of human frustration. Then men and women begin to put blame on politics, economy, psychological and societal unbalance. With the Devil inspiration, they create a culture that denies sins, and that they can practice evil things such as abortion, holy wars, free sex and many other things alike and still convinced that they are innocent or justified and even healthy.

Presenting his people to God, Moses said, “This is indeed a stiff-necked people; yet pardon our wickedness and sins and receive us as your own.” The Gospel of John says, “God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him.”

Today's culture of death is not an inspiration; it is a reaction fighting against the disturbing voice of conscience; a defensive attitude and fear presuming that God is ready to condemn his people.

Should today's Christians who believe in Jesus Christ, the Eternal Son of God, be the message for the sick and fearful world, for it is painful to say sorry, but if it is not said, healing cannot come.

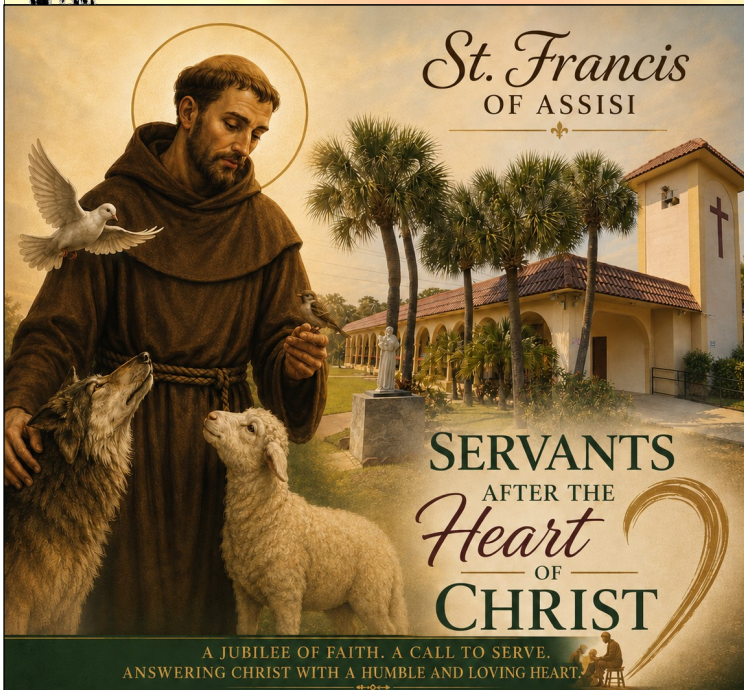
